THE PROPRIETARY GOVERNMENT WAS OVERTHROWN BY JOHN COODE AND NEHEMIAH BLAKISTON IN 1689. THIS DOCUMENT DRAWN UP IMMEDIATELY AFTERWARDS, STATES THE "ASSOCIATORS" GRIEVANCES AGAINST LORD BALTIMORE AND HIS COUNCIL AND JUSTIFIES THEIR ACTIONS.
