THAT Mr. 3 bn Walkley be appointed to all as our Secretary, and have a Silary, to be fix'd at next General Meeting, paid him out of the Publick Stock.

AS there are already Twelve Managers appointed, they are continued for this courant Year, and that on the First Thursday in April in every Year in Time coming, there be a Choice of Managers.

FOR the more orderly carrying on Debates in the General Meetings, there be a Chairman; and that one of the Twelve Managers should preside in each of those Meetings, in the Absence of the Treafurer; and that the Chairman have a small Mallet lie by him to keep Order.

THAT every Member when he wants to speak, may stand up and direct his Discourse to the Chairmin; and when he has done, to sit down; that other Members may have Liberty to speak in their Tain without Interruption.
