but one, has a mighty Advantage over fo many Sellers, who nitherto have alled without any Correspond dency among themselves, so that it has not been what Price we pleafed, but that Gentleman has fet his own Price; and if fone refused to take it for a Time, others, perhaps but one Perlon, his complyed. to take the Price fer, and then immediately every Body else have been obliged to do the same, some for one Reason, and some for another. One of the both Ressons Lever heard alledged, was, that if they did not take that Price now, by and by the Iron b would fill their Price, and then they should not get for much, which made every one crowd to offer then Inbacco, and that noturally led the Irench Agent to fell his Price, if he had not before thought of doing of it; this I think is an evident Proof, that it has not been us, but that Gentleman that made the Price woon whit Febrecobe bought.

I'H ING S being thus, I think it cannot be denied; but in this or my other Trade, where there shall be one Sole Grand tuver, of a particular Commodity, white er Price that Buyers gives; or can be obtained from him, will govern all other Buyers of that Commodity, tho there may be some Difference in the Quality of that Commodity: That this is our Case with the French. I think I need not the more Arguments to evince.

THEREFORE in my Opinion, all we have to do as to provide against this Evil; but how that is to be lone, I own is not so easy to find out.

Y h T I am throughly of Opinion, a Cure must be found, else the Trade must drop; it cannot long substitution the Terms as it has been for Years pass, the illinters have not been able to live by their Labour, and how it has been with us that have afted either is Fifthers, or Purchasters. I need not mention; every P re of the Trade has tended to Destruction, and all owing in my Opinion, to the Ascendart the
