On Motion, That a Bill be brought in for Granting a Supply for his Majesty's Service, and the better Defence and Security of this Province; Leave is given. Ordered, That Mr. Hammond, Col. Tilghman, Mr. Edward Dorsey, Mr. Matthew Tilghman, Mr. Murdock, and Mr. Carroll, do prepare and bring in a Bill accordingly.

November 11, 1757.

Col. *Tilghman* brings in and delivers to Mr. Speaker, a Bill, entituled, *An Act for granting a Supply of for his Majesty's Service, and the more immediate Defence and Security of the Frontier Inhabitants of this Province; and Emitting thereof in Bills of Credit; and Raising a Fund for Sinking and Replacing the Whole, by an*
