

XXXIV. *PROVIDED* always, and be it *Enacted*, That the Agents aforeſaid ſhall not pay out any Monies for, or on Account of the Pay, Subſiſtence, Cloathing, or any other Neceſſaries whatever, found, provided, or advanced, for or on Account of the ſaid Five Hundred Men, or any Part of them, except what is herein before directed to be paid to the Order of the Perſon or Perſons aforeſaid, before they ſhall have clear, fair and particular Accounts laid before them by the ſaid Officers, and the ſaid Doctor *David Roſs*, of the Application and Diſburſements of the ſaid Sums of Money, ſo as aforeſaid to them reſpectively advanced by his Excellency General *Forbes*, and of all their Claims of every Kind whatſoever againſt this Province, on Account of the ſaid Five Hundred Men, and ſhall carefully have inſpected, examined and adjusted, ſuch Claims and Accounts, agreeable to the Wages, Rates and Allowances, given and made by the Act of Aſſembly, by which the ſaid Five Hundred Men were taken into the Pay of this Province; nor ſhall the ſaid Agents pay to the ſaid Officers, or any of the ſaid Men, or the ſaid Doctor *David Roſs*, any greater or larger Sum or Sums of Money, than ſhall or may appear to be due to them reſpectively, deducting the ſaid Sums ſo advanced by General *Forbes* as aforeſaid, out of their reſpective Claims aforeſaid, after being adjusted as aforeſaid.

XXXV. *AND* the ſaid Agents are hereby impowered, by Order of his Excellency *Horatio Sharpe*, Eſq; or the Governor or Commander in Chief of this Province, for the Time being, as the ſame may become wanting for the Purpoſes for which they are intended by this Act, to call for, demand and receive, from the Commiſſioners or Truſtees for Emitting Bills of Credit, eſtabliſhed by Act of Aſſembly, any Part of the ſaid Six Thouſand Eight Hundred and Fourteen Pounds, or any Part of the ſaid Twenty-fix Thouſand Seven Hundred and Fifty Pounds, as alſo any other Sum or Sums of Money which they are directed to pay, lay out, or expend, by Virtue of this Act, and lay out and apply the ſame for the Purpoſes for which they are reſpectively by this Act intended; which ſaid Sums of Money, or any Part thereof, the ſaid Commiſſioners or Truſtees ſhall, and they are hereby obliged and required, immediately on Demand, and ſuch Order being produced, to pay the ſaid Agents, and regular Accounts thereof keep; and the Receipts of the ſaid Agents, or either of them, in Caſe of Sickneſs or Inability of the other, ſhall be, for the ſaid Payments, good and ſufficient Vouchers.

XXXVI. *AND* be it further *Enacted*, That before the
