in such List or Account, the Person so offending shall sorfeit and pay one fourth Part of the full Value of such concealed Stock, to be recovered as herein after directed.

LXVIII. AND be it further Enacted, by the Authority aforesaid, That for the better assessing, ordering, levying, and collecting the several Sums of Money, so as aforesaid limited and appointed to be paid, and for the more effectual putting this Act into Execution, the following Persons, in and for the several and respective Counties hereaster named, shall be Commissioners, That is to say,
