the fecond day thereof, lay them before the house of delegates, for the inspection of the members thereof.

And be it enacted, That if any of the days appoint -. ed by this act for performance of any of the duties thereby required, thall happen to be on a Sunday, then such duties shall be performed on the day following, any thing herein contained to the contrary

And be it enacted, That the collector of each respective county shall, at the time of settlement of his accounts as aforesaid, pay to each of the faid commissioners who shall serve in the execution of this act, as a salary for the full and saithful persormance of their duty therein, twenty shillings for each day they shall necessarily attend in the performance of the several services required of them by this act; and shall also pay to the said commissioners, for the use of their clerk, thirty shillings per day for every day he shall be necessarily employed in the performance of his duty; and for the use of the said affessors, for the full and faithful performance of their duty under this act, any fum not under ten pounds nor-exceeding forty pounds current money for each aff-ffor. which the faid commissioners shall adjudge an adequate reward: for the service of each assector. And the amount of all the fums fo paid shall, by the said commissioners, be allowed to the said collector on fettlement of his account as aforefaid; in which accounts shall be expressed the name of the clerk, and the names of the affessors for each hundred, and the fum of money to them respectively allowed. And the faid commissioners shall, after receipt of the faid fums for the use of their clerk and of the said asfessors, pay the same to them or their orders, respectively, on demand, under the penalty of fifty pounds current money to the party grieved.
