fince the commencement of the war, and their property, wherever found, subject to seizure and confiscation: Whereicre.

Be it enacted, by the General Affembly of Maryland, and it is hereby enasted and decared, I hat all property of British subjects (debts only excepted) be confiscated, seized, and vested, in this state, subject to the sisposition of the general afjembly.

And, Whereas the payment of quit-rent hath ceased throughout the United States fince the late happy revolution, and found policy requires that the ftate of Maryland flould not be diflinguished from all others, and that the quit-rent fliould ceate from and after the declaration of independence:

Be it the efore enacted, That nothing herein contained shall be deemed, construed, or taken, to subject the inhabitants of this state to the payment of quit-rent, arising since the declaration of independence, for the lands they may flave in possession, or be justly entitled unto, but that the same shall cease and he for ever hereatter abolished, any law, usage, or custom, to the contrary notwithstanding.
