forefaid as may be then in circulation, and to fuch other

purpoles as the legislature shall direct.

Provided nevertheless, That if any british subject, or resident of Great-Britain, is or shall be, at the time of notifying this act, an infant under the age of eighteen years, feme covert, or person non compos mentis, he or she shall, at any time within the faid fix years, have nine months after fuch disability removed, to come to this slate; and it any such infant, feme covert, or perfon non compos mentis, shall, within nine menths after fuch difability removed, and before the expiration of fix years from the faid eighteenth day of March, come to this flate, and fuch infant, or person non compos mentis, after the removal of his disability, and within twenty days after coming to this state as aforefaid, shall take and subscribe the said oath, then this act nor any thing therein contained, shall be construed or taken to deprive such infant, feme covert, or person non compos mentis, of the principal of his or her estite and property, but the same shall be reffored; nor shall this act, nor any thing therein contained, be taken or construed to deprive any widow residing within this state of her right of dower or thirds, or any feme covert, during her life, of the third part of and in any estate or property which shall be taken in virtue of this act, but the same sower and thirds shall be assigned to such widow or seme covers at the time of taking the property and estates as aforefaid.

And be it enacted, That the commissioners to be appointed as atorefaid shall and may sell and dispose of all perishable articles, found upon, belonging to, or of the produce of, the estates aforesaid, at the time of taking the same, and shall render accounts thereof, and pay the product of such sales into the treasury, to be applied to the purposes aforesaid, which accounts shall be kept as evidences to ascertain the value of such perishable articles.

And be it further enacted, That no alienation, conveyance, or transfer, hereafter made or executed by any British subject, resident of Great-Britain, or by any of the persons above described, shall be valid or effectual in law, unless such British subject, resident of Great-Britain, or person as above described, come to this state, and take and subscribe the

eath aforesaid within the time aforesaid.
