

foreſaid as may be then in circulation, and to ſuch other purpoſes as the legiſlature ſhall direct.

*Provided nevertheless,* That if any Britiſh ſubject, or reſident of Great-Britain, is or ſhall be, at the time of notifying this act, an infant under the age of eighteen years, ſeme covert, or perſon non compos mentis, he or ſhe ſhall, at any time within the ſaid ſix years, have nine months after ſuch diſability removed, to come to this ſtate; and if any ſuch infant, ſeme covert, or perſon non compos mentis, ſhall, within nine months after ſuch diſability removed, and before the expiration of ſix years from the ſaid eighteenth day of March, come to this ſtate, and ſuch infant, or perſon non compos mentis, after the removal of his diſability, and within twenty days after coming to this ſtate as aforeſaid, ſhall take and ſubſcribe the ſaid oath, then this act nor any thing therein contained, ſhall be conſtrued or taken to deprive ſuch infant, ſeme covert, or perſon non compos mentis, of the principal of his or her eſtate and property, but the ſame ſhall be reſtored; nor ſhall this act, nor any thing therein contained, be taken or conſtrued to deprive any widow reſiding within this ſtate of her right of dower or thirds, or any ſeme covert, during her life, of the third part of and in any eſtate or property which ſhall be taken in virtue of this act, but the ſame dower and thirds ſhall be aſſigned to ſuch widow or ſeme covert at the time of taking the property and eſtates as aforeſaid.

*And be it enacted,* That the commiſſioners to be appointed as aforeſaid ſhall and may ſell and diſpoſe of all perſhable articles, found upon, belonging to, or of the produce of, the eſtates aforeſaid, at the time of taking the ſame, and ſhall render accounts thereof, and pay the product of ſuch ſales into the treaſury, to be applied to the purpoſes aforeſaid, which accounts ſhall be kept as evidences to aſcertain the value of ſuch perſhable articles.

*And be it further enacted,* That no alienation, conveyance, or transfer, hereafter made or executed by any Britiſh ſubject, reſident of Great-Britain, or by any of the perſons above deſcribed, ſhall be valid or effectual in law, unleſs ſuch Britiſh ſubject, reſident of Great-Britain, or perſon as above deſcribed, come to this ſtate, and take and ſubſcribe the oath aforeſaid within the time aforeſaid.
