

lect and levy the rate from such person according to such abatement or increase.

*And be it enacted,* That the commissioners of the tax shall have full power to call the several assessors before them, at the time limited for appeals, or at such other times as they in their discretion shall think reasonable, for the purpose of correcting their valuation of property; and the said commissioners shall have full authority, and they are hereby directed carefully to examine the several certificates of valuation in their respective counties, and to correct the same, though no complaint or appeal to them, so as to make the same as nearly equal as possible.

*And be it enacted,* That the property of each assessor shall be valued by the commissioners of his county, or any one of them, on or before the fifteenth day of April next, in the same manner as the property of other persons by this act is directed to be estimated by the assessors; which valuation shall be added to the certificate of the district in which such assessor's property shall be, collected in the same manner as other assessments are directed to be collected.

*And be it enacted,* That the commissioners of the tax shall, at their first meeting, or within ten days thereafter, appoint such person as they may judge most proper to be collector of the tax in their county, and the person so appointed shall appear before the commissioners within five days after notice of his appointment, and in their presence enter into bond, with good and sufficient securities, such as they shall approve, in double the sum to be collected, with condition, "that if the above bound ————— shall well and faithfully execute and perform the several duties required of him as collector of the tax for ——— county, according to law, then the above obligation to be void, else to remain in full force;" and the commissioners shall witness the execution of such bond,
