

the same notice shall be given; which said sales shall be for current money; and if no effects can be found on the said land, the same shall be chargeable with the assessment which may be unpaid, with six per cent. interest thereon from the fifteenth day of April next, in the hands of any purchaser; and any goods at any time found on the premises shall be liable to distress and sale for payment thereof; and the respective collectors shall, from time to time, disclose to the commissioners of his county, his receipts of the rate imposed by this act, and shall, from time to time, pay to the treasurer of his shire, by direction of the commissioners, as far as he shall have received, so that no great sum of money may long remain in his hands.

And be it enacted, That the commissioners of the tax in each county are hereby empowered to draw their order on the present or late collector of the tax in their county, having public money in their hands, in favour of the receiver of specifics, for such sum of money as they may judge necessary, not exceeding fifty pounds, to enable him to proceed in the execution of his office; and the governor and council are also requested to advance, from time to time, such sums of money, by their order on the treasurer of either shire, as they may judge necessary to enable the said receivers to defray the expences which they may incur in the execution of this act.

And be it enacted, That each of the said collectors shall appear at the place of holding the county court for his county, on the first day of July next, and then and there lay before the commissioners of his county an accurate and fair account of his collection of the half part of the rate aforesaid, under the penalty of two hundred pounds current money; and the said commissioners shall appear at the same time and place, under the penalty of twenty pounds on each commissioner not appearing, unless prevented by sick-
