the number of flaves of each description within this act, the weight of plate, the number of horles and black cattle, and the value of each of the laid species or kind of property, and all the other property, and the value thereof, in each district; and the whole value in each cillrict extended, and the amount of each column, and shall lay the same before the commissioners, who, after correction thereof, if necessary, shall fign and enclose the same, endersed for the public fervice, to the clerk of the house of delegates, and shail, within five days thereafter, und r penalty of fifty pounds on each commissioner, deliver the fame to the sheriff of their county, to be by him forwarded as public letters, and under the like penalty; and the clerk of the house of delegates shall enter the faid fummary account in a book to be provided for that purpose, and keep the original in his office, and on the second day of the next meeting of the general asfembly he shall lay the same before the house of delegates, for the inspection of the members.

And be it enacted. That every person shall, on or before the fifteenth cay of September next, pay to the coilector or his deputy, in the district where his property was valued, the relidue of the faid rate imposed by this act; or he may discharge ten shillings, part thereof, in any of the specific articles aforesaid, at the prices and in the manner aforefaid, on or before the fisteenth day of September next; and if any person shall not make payment by the said day, the respective collectors are hereby authorised and quired to collect the same by distress and sale, in the manner before directed; and the collectors shall make payment by direction of the commissioners, as herein before directed, and his final account shall be fettled by the commissioners on or before the first day of December seventeen hundred and eighty-three, and the balance thereof shall be paid
