FARM AND HOUSEHOLD.

The following is the experience of Mr. C. B. Rogers, Secotan, No. 123 Market St., Philadelphia: As the time has now arrived for farmers to select their seed wheat; I wish to give the following as the experience of some of the best farmers in this country...

It is undoubtedly better for farmers in this country to change their seed from one locality to another, to fully preserve its health and vigor...

Quick-Paying Fruits. We are often asked what sort of fruit pay the best and the speediest? Life is short, say you, and we are to be here but a short time...

1. A Patch of Strawberries.—If young plants are not to be depended on, they will bear a fair crop the following spring, and a full crop the second season.

2. A Patch of Raspberries.—These may be set out in spring or fall. Cut back the canes to three buds. After they have set out, they must have a liberal cultivation in summer, and suitable protection in winter.

3. Gooseberries and Currants.—These can be grown from cuttings, which any neighbor can give you. They are easy to grow and pay well. In the course of two or three years, one's berries will be in full bearing...

4. Grapes.—These like the Currant and Gooseberry, can be grown from cuttings and layers, but it saves a year or two of time to plant the vines in the spring.

5. Peaches, Dwarf Peas, Apples, Cherries, &c.—These are all profitable crops, and need no special mention. Near we extend the encouragement for whoever has a garden of vegetables maturing the first summer, and a choice collection of the fruits we have named, coming on from the first of June may well be content.—Heath and How.
