Letter from Minnesota.

ANOKA, Minn., January 29th, 1871. DEAR WIRIO--Thinking of few lines from a former resident of old Cecil would be acceptable to the readers of your worthy paper.

We will commence with Summer, which occasionally is as warm as in Maryland, but only for a short time, in the middle of the day, morning and evening being always cool and pleasant, no matter how hot the day, evening brings a breeze which cools off everything.

ANOKA resembles old Fort Deposit, a little, as it lies along the banks of Rum River, and you will always see lumber, look which way you will. The river takes its name from a fight the Indians and early settlers had on it over a keg of fire-water.
