THE HAY CROP. The hay crop, in point of value, is considered second to no other grown in the United States, and yet in some parts of the country where stock live out of doors and shift for themselves all winter, this crop is not appreciated.

The cost of cutting grass and making it into hay, thirty years ago, was much greater in proportion to the amount of hay made, than at the present time.

The question comes up here—how are we to enrich our land to produce such good results? We cannot dispute that our land is capable of being thus improved.

In Europe, there is a great saving of hay by the use of root crops. This has been tried to some extent in this country, but as a general rule has not been successful.

Mrs. SMITH.—I find that cabbage, cauliflower, and all leaves, as well as greens, if boiled in hard water, preserve their color better than if the water is soft.

Mrs. JAMISON.—My way of cooking green peas is as follows: I prepare them until nearly done in salt water, then drain, put into a stew-pan flour and butter, stir them together, and moisten with a spoonful or two of milk or veal gravy.

Mrs. BLAND.—Lettuce should be freshly gathered and placed for an hour in cold water, then drained, and cut in thin slices.

Mrs. LESTER.—We shall soon have new potatoes, and as they are not very plentiful, being eaten frequently before they are fully ripe for the table, I suggest that they be first boiled, then mashed, mixed with the yolk of an egg, salt, milk, and butter, and baked in an hour.

Hints on Canning Fruit. The season when fruit will be plenty is before the end of the month, and those housekeepers who have seen how much their canned fruit was enjoyed the last winter, will be making calculations to put up a large supply the present summer.
