

FRANK GREEN'S LOG.

Leaving New York at 12 o'clock noon on the day above mentioned, by noon the next day, the reckoning proved the ship had run 263 miles in 24 hours. Sailing east the voyager gains about half an hour of daylight in the twenty-four; while he loses the same on the homeward bound voyage.

Friday at noon the good ship had made 300 miles; and on Saturday, 337. On Sunday at 11 A. M., the ship was 400 miles from New York, and the passengers assembled in the saloon, and the first Mate read the service of the Episcopal Church. The saloon of the China was a splendid apartment, fitted up in a style that few of the best hotel parlors can equal.

Thursday being the 4th of July was not observed on board the English ship. Green and three other Americans celebrated the day in a bottle of brown stout on deck, which they drank in a quiet way to the stars and stripes.

At 12 o'clock on the following Saturday the reckoning made the distance to Liverpool 106 miles, and in the afternoon of that day the Irish coast came in view, presenting one of the most charming landscapes that ever greeted the eye of man.

Here our "ancient mariner" spent the night and took the cars the next morning for Kilmarnock, Scotland, the clouds still dropping. He asked a boy, whose chief occupation seemed to be to look after the dripping passengers making their way to the steamer, if it always rained in Liverpool, who answered: "No, it rains sometimes for a change."

Of the scores of companions left here when young manhood went out into the untrodden world to buffet fortune, the wanderer with wilting locks found not one. A two days' search in Kilmarnock discovered two or three old settlers who had a slight recollection of the stranger from the land of promise which lies toward the setting sun.

At Glasgow our hero in search of the friends of his youth, paid 64 fare to Londonderry, Ireland, which is a part rail-road and part steamboat, and after a run of 14 hours, found himself on the soil of "old Ireland," the land of his birth.
