HOW TO MAKE GOOD BUTTER.

From the Maryland Farmer. The "Stock Journal" of Chicago publishes an excellent essay by Hon. Charles W. Murtfeldt, Secretary of the Missouri Board of Agriculture on the management of the Dairy and the Stock.

The first point in making good butter is good food, and in sufficient quantity to stimulate and keep up the appetite of the milk cows.

"We will suppose the time of the year to be the month of June and the time of day to be six o'clock P. M. We have a dairy, say of twenty cows, and there are two or three milkers.
