## THE BIG TRACTOR DEMONSTRATION.

BE A GREAT EV. ENT FOR QUEEN ANNE'S FARMERS.

Wednesday, August 7th, will be a Red Letter Day for the farmers of Queen Annes and Talbot counties at the big Tractor Demonstration to be held on the Rathell farm, near Wye Mills.

The field to be plowed has a stiff, beavy sod and will give each machine a good test. Each tractor will be required to do the same work, under the same conditions, as far as pos-

Several new tractors, not common in this locality, will participate in this test, and the farmers will have an excellent opportunity to determine just what tractor is best suited to the conditions in this section of the State.

The farm labor situation naturally brings up the question of the advisability of tractors replacing borses and extra men, and every one interested should attend this demonstration so as to get first hand information.

The youth of America is awake. "To farms" as well as "to arms" is the cry: Boys by the thousands are going from the cities to the farms in a mation-wide movement to handle the big crops that must be grown to serve our Allies as well as ourselves. Many of these boys, in all probability, will take up farming in the near future as an occupation, and the tractor will naturally make farm life more attractive than the horse-drawn implemente.

### A LITTLE FARM ADVICE.

Alfalfa to be seeded this season should be sown between August 20th and September 1st. In order to have the seed bed in the proper condition at that time, the preparation should begin now Have the seed bed fine and firm with moisture sufficient to start the small plants. Alfalfa started at this season is more successful

than when sown in the spring Keep your eye on the herd of hogs. leolate the first one that shows signs of sickness. If he does not get better within a few days, or others show trouble, report it and save your other bogs and those of your neighbors This is the season for cholera Burn or bury deeply all dead carcasses of all descriptions




