Gen. Ghoruko. Eighty Turkish officers and four guns were captured. The Russian loss was 2,500, and was about equal on the part of the Turks.

The Russian pursuit of the shattered forces of Ghazizadeh in Armenia has created a panic at Erzerum, and it was believed that the Turks had retreated to Koprikoi, but Ghazizadeh reports that the Russians have not advanced further than Wellidogh on the western slope of Soghunli Dagh.

The latest advices from Erzerum state that the situation is becoming critical. The Russians are advancing, and a battle will probably soon take place near Koprikoi, where the joint commands of Ismail Pasha and Ghazizadeh are posted.
