Of these 2,305 were on the subject of the tariff, 300 were in favor of extending the suffrage to women, 501 were on subjects pertaining to commerce and 187 were in favor of regulating and restricting the liquor traffic.

Moose-Hunting.

There are three modes of hunting the moose, termed still hunting, fire-hunting, and calling. There was another mode, which, I am happy to say, legislation has in a great measure suppressed.

To be successful in still-hunting, or creeping upon a moose, necessitates the aid of a skillful Indian guide, very few, if any, white men ever attain the marvelous precision with which an Indian, to whom the pathless forest is an open book...

The finely modulated voice of the Indian is especially adapted to imitate the different calls and cries of the denizens of the forest, and with a trumpet of birch bark, he will imitate to the life, the plaintive low of the cow-moose, and the responsive bellow of the bull.

The Indian called to detect the counterfeiter. If the call is successful, presently the responsive bull moose is heard crashing through the forest, uttering his blood-curdling bellow or roar, and rattling his horns against the trees in challenge to all rivals, as he comes to the death which awaits him.

Fire-hunting, or hunting by torch-light, is practiced by exhibiting a bright light, formed by burning bunches of birch bark, in places known to be frequented by moose.

The mode of hunting which generally prevails is that of still-hunting, or creeping upon the moose, which is undoubtedly the most sportsman-like way, and affords the greatest pleasure.
