

**GENERAL SUMMARY.**

A lamentable accident occurred in Naples a few days ago, during the procession of the Corpus Domini. A party, consisting of the Duke di Martina, the Duchess di Sango, her four daughters, the oldest of whom is married to the Duke di Bagnoli, and a little boy, were watching the procession from a balcony overlooking the street. The Duke di Martina, leaning over the balcony railing, fell and was precipitated among the crowd below. Fortunately all escaped serious injuries, but severe contusions were inflicted upon the Duke, who, striking first on the railing of the lower balcony and thence rebounding into the street, fractured his spine and survived only two hours.

Saturday afternoon Prof. S. W. Colgate, accompanied by Miss Emma Allison, made a balloon ascension from San Francisco, and came down to the bay, on account of a rent in the bag. The balloon dragged two miles through the water in the same number of minutes, struck the piles of an old wharf opposite San Francisco, threw out both occupants, who fell somewhat and bruised, but not seriously injured, and rose again and sailed away coming down at Lathrop, forty miles. Colgate and Miss Allison, after wading through a marsh, made their way to San Francisco.

Cleopatra's Needle had scarcely been set up in London before it became necessary to preserve it in some way from disintegration. This, it is said, has been secured by the use of a solution, probably a sulfate, which has greatly improved the appearance of the monolith.

The negro who outraged Miss Edwards, near Lindale, Texas, last Wednesday, was captured Friday, and literally hacked to pieces by a mob.

Joseph A. Blair, who shot and killed his coachman near Newark, N. J., has been admitted to bail in \$1,000.

The absence of violent winds has been a marked feature of the season in Ohio, and farmers have been able to harvest a splendid stand of grain. The yield in that State is in excess of last year, and other crops promise well. The hay crop is not heavy, but superior to last year's in quality. Advice from South Carolina is that cotton never looked better while the agent and cost of it is the largest ever known in that State. Corn has suffered from a drought. Of what a remarkably fine average to the acre is reported. It is estimated by the St. Paul (Minn.) Pioneer Press that the farmers of that State will realize \$40,000,000 for their wheat crop this year. The Chicago Times figures for the new crop for the favored States at 300,000 bushels, a falling off of about 35,000,000 bushels from last year. On her visit of condolence to the ex-Empress Eugenie Queen Victoria was accompanied by Princess Beatrice, Prince Leopold, and the Marchioness of Elby as lady in waiting. Too weak to descend from her own room, the ex-Empress Queen received the Queen and the lady-in-waiting in another room. Her Majesty remained for upwards of half an hour. Toward the close of the visit, and just as the Queen was leaving, Prince Leopold and Princess Beatrice were received by the ex-Empress, with whom they remained for a few minutes before their departure. As the train started the Queen appeared to be in the deepest grief, shedding tears as she entered the saloon carriage.

A dispatch from Atlanta, Ga., announces the death, at the residence of Governor Colquitt, in that city, Saturday evening last, of Rev. Dr. Alexander Clark, editor of the Methodist Recorder, Pittsburg, Pa. Dr. Clark went to a college commencement, and on his way back visited Atlanta. Here he was taken sick, and had been ill for several weeks. He was a brilliant writer, an eloquent preacher, and the author of several books which have had extensive circulation.
