Philadelphia Evening Telegraph: "Mr. Cornell goes into the governorship on a partial republican vote, supplemented by so much of the rag-tag and bob-tail elect of the democratic party as could be induced to follow the lead of Mr. John Kelly, the Tammany Hall boss."

Philadelphia Record: "The defeat of Gov. Robinson in New York is not so much an advertisement of the strength of Tammany as of the weakness of Tilden. It is simply a notice of the democracy of New York to the democracy of the Union."

Phila. North American: "Against the South we have no animosity. For its people as a mass this journal entertains only the warmest sympathies in all things that merit esteem or success."

Philadelphia Inquirer: "The country is upon the eve of one of the most momentous struggles in its political history, and it behooves every republican and every patriotic citizen to prepare for the final battle with the 'solid South' and its Northern allies."

Washington Star: "The peculiar aspect of the war in New York State is that the presidential election is not yet settled in favor of the republicans. They have elected Cornell and carried the Legislature, but it is pretty evident that but for John Kelly's defection Robinson would have been elected, and this leaves the question in doubt whether the democrats cannot carry the great pivotal State in 1880; that is, if the factions can succeed in harmonizing their quarrels and uniting upon a presidential candidate."

Washington (Del.) Every Evening: "The universal opinion seems to be that the defeat of Gov. Robinson puts Mr. Tilden outside the list of possible democratic candidates, and it is equally the opinion of all intelligent democrats outside New York that the manner of Robinson's defeat ought to and will put John Kelly and those who still adhere to him out of the councils of the democratic party."

New York Commercial Advertiser: "New York is under more obligations to John Kelly than to the New York Evening Post. New York Times and Harper's Weekly for his election. He may thank his stars that the Times did not succeed in driving Kelly from the field. Had it succeeded the State would have been hopelessly democratic."

New York Journal of Commerce: "Whatever the future has in store for us, we hope that this tendency towards independence of mere party control will be encouraged until the wisest and best of all parties can be depended upon to act together, at least in all matters of local concern."
