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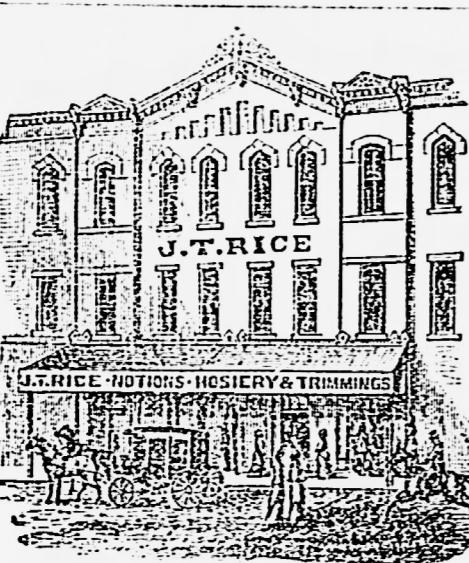

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The Capture of the "Huascar."

The recent naval conflict between the Peruvian iron-clad Huascar and the Chilean armed ships Abtauro, Cochrane and Blanco Encalada has excited a great deal of general interest. The engagement between these vessels took place on the 8th of October, and has just been called the greatest combat between iron-clad ships that the world has ever seen.

It was some time after three o'clock on the morning of the day of battle that the Huascar, cruising off Antofagasta, signalled her consort, the Union, that the enemy was in sight, and immediately proceeded at full speed to the northward, hoping to elude the vigilance of the Chileans.

At a little aft of the gun turret is the watch-tower of the commander, hexagonal, and composed of plates of three-inch iron outside, then eight inches of teak, and inside a half an inch of iron, leaving just room in the interior for easy movement of the person placed there.

According to Chilean account, which is the most circumstantial that has reached us, the flag of the Huascar was shot away at twenty-five minutes past ten, and it was supposed that the vessel had surrendered.

It was nearly ten o'clock—that is, after the battle had lasted half an hour—when a heavy shell from the Cochrane struck the tower, within which Admiral Grau always took his place during action.
