N ACT to repeal sections pinety-four, ninety-five,ninety-six,ninety-seven and ninety eight of Article fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws title "Howard County, "sub-title "Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks," so far as the same applies to that part of the Second elec-tion district of Howard County, included within the corporate limits of Ellicott City, and to add new sections to said Article fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, to follow section ninety eight, to be designated as sections ninety-eight A, ninety-eight B, ninety eight C, ninety eight D, ninety eight E, ninety eight F and ninety

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections ninety-four, ninety-five, ninety-six ninety-seven, and ninety eight, of Arti cle fourteen of the Code of Public Local 'Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks," so far as the same applies to that part of limits of Ellicott City, be and the same is hereby repealed, and that new sections to come in after section ninety-eight of said Article fourteen be added thereto, to be known as sections ninety-eight A ninety-eight B, ninety-eight C, ninety eight D, ninety-eight E, ninety-eight F and ninety-eight G.

98 A. No person after the first day o May, eighteen hundred and ninety-two, shall sell, barter, offer for sale, barter or keep for sale or barter in that part of the Second election district of Howard County, included within the corporate limits of Ellicott City, any spirituous or fermented liquors or tager beer except as hereinafter provided.

98 B. Any person desiring to obtain a license to sell spirituous or fermented iquors or lager beer in that part of the econd election district of Howard County included within the corporate limits of Ellicott City, shall file an application in writing with the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Howard County, in which he shallstate; first his or her name and that he or she is a resident of the Second election district of Howard County; second, that he or she is a citizen of the United States, and has been for twelve months next preceding the filing of such application, a bona fide resident of the State of Maryland; third that the applicant is not, or if the appli cation is by a firm, that none of the applicants are in any manner pecuniarily interested in the profits of any business It Preserves and Beautifies, Making conducted at any other place in that art of Ellicott City affected by this sub title where any spirituous or fermented iquors are sold or kept for sale; and fourth, the particular place where the business is to be conducted under the license sought, specifying the same by definite designation and description; which said application shall be verified by the affidavit of the applicant, made before the Clerk of the Court to whom the application is made, and if any false statement is made in any part of said application the applicant or applicants hall be guilty of perjury and upon in dictment and conviction shall be punished accordingly, and any license is sued upen such application shall be sup-

98 C. There shall be annexed to said application a certificate signed by at least five reputable freeholders, bona fide residents of that part of Ellicott City affected by the sub-title in which the persons certifying shall state that they recommend the applicant as a suitable person to whom such a license should be

98 D. Upon said application and certificate being filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Howard County, the said Clerk shall issue to such applicant a license for a period not longer than twelve months upon receiving from said applicant the following sum or license fee, viz: If the license be for twelve months, and to sell spirituous and fer mented liquors and lager beer the sum of three hundred dollars; if issued for a shorter period, the licensee shall pay for every month, or fractional part of a month for which his or her license is to run, one-twelfth of the annual charge for such license, and all such licenses shall expire on the first day of May 8 N. HOLLIDAY ST., BALTIMORE, MD. succeeding the day on which they are

Howard County for the license aforesaid shall be paid over quarterly by said clerk to the State as other license moneys are paid as now provided by law, and when so paid over the Comptroller of the Treasury shall draw his warrant npon the Treasurer in favor of the layor and City Council of Ellicott City for three-fourths thereof, to be applied to the general use of said city.

98 F. Every person receiving a license under this sub title shall frame his or he license under a glass and place the same so that it shall at all times be conspicu ous and easily read in his or her chief place of making his or her sales, and no license issued under this sub-title shall authorize sales by any person who shall neglect this requirement. 98. G. Any person or persons or com

pany having a license under the provi sions of this sub-title who shall hereaf convicted of violating of the provisions of this Act, or the conditions of his, her, or their license, shall be subject to a fine of not less than one hundred nor more than six hundred dollars; and for any second offense whereof he, she, or they shall be convicted, his, her or their license shall be vacated and revoked, and he, she or they, shall be subjected to a fine of not less than than five hundred dollars nor more than one thousand dollars, or to imprison ment in the jail of Howard County, o in the House of Correction for not less three months nor more than twelve months, or to both fine and imprison ment in the discretion of the court. The license of any person or company who permits minors to frequent or loiter about his, her or their place, or disrepu-table or disorderly persons to make it a customary place of visitation or resort, may be at any time upon proof, revoked by the Circuit Court for Howard County, or by the Mayor, Counsellor and City Council of Ellicott City, the same person shall not again be licensed within
