### HOWARD COUNTY LOCAL LAW.

#### CHAPTER 281.

AN ACT to repeal sections ninety-four, ninety-five, ninety-six, ninety-seven and ninety-eight of Article fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, and to amend said County "sub-title" "Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks," so far as the same applies to that part of the Second election district of Howard County, included within the corporate limits of Ellicott City, and to add new sections to said Article fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, to follow section ninety-eight, to be designated as sections ninety-eight A, ninety-eight B, ninety-eight C, ninety-eight D, ninety-eight E, ninety-eight F and ninety-eight G.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections ninety-four, ninety-five, ninety-six, ninety-seven, and ninety-eight, of Article fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, titled "Howard County," sub-title "Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks," so far as the same applies to that part of the Second election district of Howard County included within the corporate limits of Ellicott City, be and the same is hereby repealed, and that new sections to come in after section ninety-eight of said Article fourteen be and they are to be known as sections ninety-eight A, ninety-eight B, ninety-eight C, ninety-eight D, ninety-eight E, ninety-eight F, and ninety-eight G.

SECTION 2. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections ninety-four, ninety-five, ninety-six, ninety-seven, and ninety-eight, of Article fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, titled "Howard County," sub-title "Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks," so far as the same applies to that part of the Second election district of Howard County included within the corporate limits of Ellicott City, be and the same is hereby repealed, and that new sections to come in after section ninety-eight of said Article fourteen be and they are to be known as sections ninety-eight A, ninety-eight B, ninety-eight C, ninety-eight D, ninety-eight E, ninety-eight F, and ninety-eight G.

SECTION 3. There shall be annexed to said application a certificate signed by at least five reputable freeholders, bona fide residents of that part of Ellicott City affected by the said title, in which the persons certifying shall state that they recommend the applicant as a suitable person to whom such a license should be issued.

SECTION 4. Upon said application and certificate being filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Howard County, the said Clerk shall issue to said applicant a license for the period not longer than twelve months upon receiving from said applicant the following sum or license fee, viz: If the license be for twelve months, and to sell spirituous or fermented liquors and lager beer the sum of three hundred dollars; if issued for a shorter period, the licensee shall pay for such license, and all such licenses shall expire on the first day of May, succeeding the day on which they are issued.

SECTION 5. The whole of the money received by the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Howard County for the license fees, after said shall be paid over quarterly by said clerk to the State as other license fees are paid as now provided by law, and when so paid over the Comptroller of the Treasury shall draw his warrant upon the Treasurer in favor of the Mayor and City Council of Ellicott City for three-fourths thereof, to be applied to the general use of said city.
