Flies That Build Nests.

The gauramis are chiefly remarkable for the fact that they build nests like birds. At the breeding season they pair off, each couple selecting a spot among water plants and forming a nest by cutting out a piece of a peculiar kind of floating weed, which grows in tufts on the surface of the ponds, and plastered with mud. The nest is usually about six inches in diameter, the construction occupying the fish for five or six days. Where they are propagated their task is made easier by placing in the water branches of bamboo, to which bunches of the grass referred to are attached. The gauramis take this grass and with it make their nest in the submerged branches of bamboo. When it is finished, the female deposits her eggs in it to the number of from 80 to 100.

While the eggs are undergoing the process of incubation the parents guard the nest carefully, and are very fiercely on the trader, and this care for the safety of their young is continued after the latter are hatched. During infancy the young ones find refuge in the nest from a thousand dangers which would otherwise threaten them, and the grass composing the nest furnishes them with their earliest food.

When the young are a few days old the small fry begin to make short excursions from the nest, always in charge of their parents and swimming together in a school. This is continued until they are able to look out for themselves.—Washington Star.

The Carthusian Table.

Not a great way from Monterey, Mexico, is the famous Carthusian table, one of the greatest natural curiosities on the North American continent. It is a tableland, 1,400 feet high and 2,500 feet across.

The figure of the tableland is an almost perfect crescent, running east and west, and on its summit is more than 80,000 acres of perfectly level land, abounding in running water. The only way to reach the top is by a perilous road five feet wide and three miles long. This singular mountain was named after the Carthusian monks by a former tribe of Indians who occupied it and were taught by the fathers. It is now owned as a summer resort by Senor Don Patricio Melina, a rich banker of Monterey, a lucky Irishman who, in his native land, was known as plain Pat Mullens.—Yankee Blade.
