A TANGLE IN ANOTHER COUNTY.

Washington county is just now confronted with a tangle in its school affairs similar to that which has been attempted in Howard.

For twenty-four years Mr. Peter A. Witmer has been secretary and treasurer to the board of county school commissioners and examiner of public schools.

Instead of gracefully accepting the result of the contest he had entered, Mr. Witmer showed his teeth and refused to surrender his office, coolly informing the school commissioners that he did not recognize them as a constitutional body.

It is assumed that steps will be taken at once to oust Mr. Witmer, as it is not expected that his usefulness regard for the cause of public education has developed sufficiently in a quarter century to induce him to recede from his position and refrain from raising a legal quibble, for selfish reasons, although the public school machinery of the State is thereby paralyzed.
