**IS KISSING OUT OF DATE?**  
A Few Remarks Tending to Favor the Bourgeoisie.  
Kissing goes, they say, by favor. And experts say that it is certain through all time that kissing has a certain flavor and a great many other elements which appeal to the imagination of mankind. Therefore, when a hand of women in Brooklyn decide that kissing is out of date and not to be encouraged, it behooves everybody who has been or expects to be kissed to look into the subject.  
Men and women have kissed for some 5,000 years, and sociologists agree that the race was never more perfectly developed than it is today. The new school insists that kissing is apt to convey disease, that when lip bacteria are interchanged, that all sorts of infectious diseases are passed on by these enthusiasts, labial mediums. Are these methods straight, or are they wrong?  
There are many kinds of kisses. The kiss of a mother is not the kiss of a lover, and people who do not know a piece of kissing babies do not attach as much importance to the exercise as people who kiss only when some strong emotion prompts them. Long experience shows that kissing is inevitable. Otherwise the world would not have kept on kissing through all these years and down through ages full of change and vicissitude. Nobody will deny that science has advanced with gigantic strides during the last decade, but when science tries to deprive the world of osculation it attempts the impossible. Civilization has progressed, population has increased. He has assumed a thousand new and beneficent phases, and yet kissing has been going on all the time. Zymotic diseases have been consistently prevalent in preceding periods of the world's history, and they may have been interchanged by communication of the lips, but the race has managed to survive, and here we are today.  
The experience is well remembered of that medical student who found in his first year at college that he was possessed of all the ills which the common man has that every cold blooded scientist who has ever kissed or been kissed imagines himself to be afflicted with every possible disease that can be communicated by kissing. It is not worth while to discuss how manifold these diseases are. The fact remains that the race has managed to worry along in spite of them.—New York Press.

**JOY of Building a Suburban House.**  
The ideal suburbanite has no time to fool with an architect. He supervises the construction of that house himself. A laudable and loving ambition, for is it not his home? The suburbanite is content with this arrangement. It takes them about five minutes to ascertain just how much less than nothing it is possible for a man to know about house building and yet be able to distinguish an eugenic hole from a mortise. When he speaks of "jigs" as "jols," he talks his measure. And when he calls "stud" "studding," he is up to his ears in the commonest and getting deeper every step. But, blessed be the placid bliss of perfect ignorance, he doesn't know it. He is serenely happy. He proclaims about that house going into trouble at every turn. He falls through the first floor "jigs" and abrades his happy shins. He looks up to see what is the matter when the downward sodden soil of the second floor about "Look out below!" and catches a hatchet handle in his eye. He walks under the scaffolding when the plasterers are at work and gets gongs of mortar on top of his head, and when the lack of his intention. The cry of appeal, the germ of the demonstrative roots, preludes to nouns of number, sex and distance; the emotional cry of which our simple intelligence and composition, combining with the demonstratives, prepares the verb and the noun of condition and action.  
Imitation, either direct or symbolical, but necessarily only approximate, of the sounds of nature, or, in short, onomatopoeia, furnishes the elements of attributive poetry, from which proceed the names of objects and special qualities and their derivatives. Analogy and metaphor complete the vocabulary by applying to objects of touch, sight, smell and taste the qualifications derived from onomatopoeia. Then comes reason, which, ascertaining the greater or smaller number of sounds reduced to a vague or general sense, and by derivation, suffixing and composition causes to proceed from these subunits indefinite lineages of words, having every manner of relationship among themselves, from the closest to the most distant, which grammar proceeds to distribute among the recognized categories of parts of speech.
