THE CHINESE ARMY.

The well known Russian traveler Grun Grimaldo has described in a masterly manner, in the Historical Magazine, the typical characteristics of that part of the Chinese army the men of which are called "Yoons," or the bravest.

Their armament is in the highest degree varied; one has a rifle; a second, a sword; a third, both rifle and sword; a fourth, a spear; in fact, so diverse is their armament that it is impossible to describe the numerous variations.

The non-commissioned officers possess revolvers and swords, but the officers are entirely unarmed. At first sight this seems remarkable, but one speedily becomes accustomed to this characteristic peculiarity of the Chinese army, the more so when one suddenly recollects that the greater number of Chinese officers receive no special training in the knowledge of their duties, and that scarcely a fourth part of them ever receive any military education.

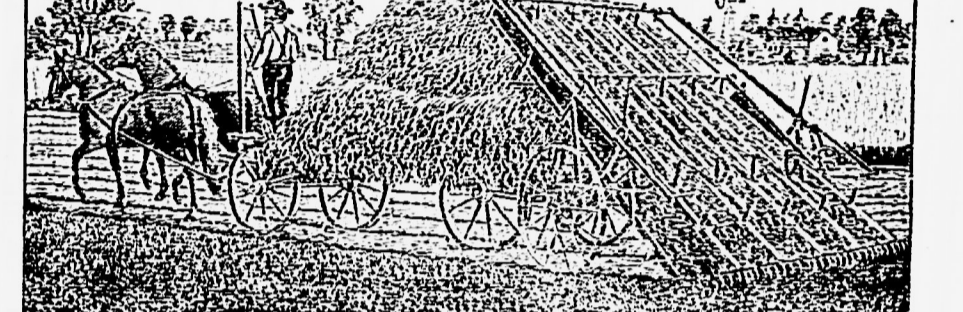
