THE COOPER'S HAWK.

Mr. Chas. B. Cook, writing to the Country Gentleman says: The Cooper's hawk so closely resembles the pigeon or sharp-shinned hawk that the two species may be economically treated together.

Both these species are very abundant over the greater part of North America. They are the hawks that are distinctive of the reputation that has been falsely conferred upon the beneficial species.

The Cooper's hawk has earned a good reputation, but over the greater part of its range it is a terror to bird and fowl alike. Even the swift flying partridge or grouse, early in the season, is in some places, must be in a dense thicket to stand any chance of escape, and even then an escape is due to a timely drop into some brushy place, where its protective color and mottled form come to the rescue.

When a sharp-shinned or Cooper's hawk attacks a flock of poultry, its visits are likely to be continued for some time. It will continue to fly about the flock, and when a sharp-shinned hawk swooped down on one of them, but missed his bird, as the pigeon fairly brushed him off in flying through the lowest space in a bush or fence.

Both the above species at times are exceedingly bold, and seem to depend on their rapid wings to carry them off safely. A few years ago one was known to attack the person of Mr. C. D. Walcott, in Lewis County, New York.

THE LOCOMOTIVE FIREMAN.

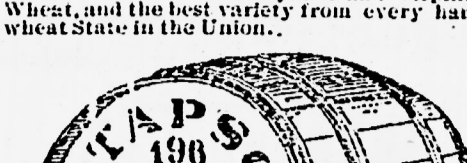
