A New Illuminant. In experiments looking to the reduction of certain compounds of aluminum and calcium in an electric furnace Prof. P. L. Wilson, of North Carolina, is said to have produced a compound of these elements which, when burned in oxygen, decomposes with the emission of an inflammable gas. This gas, in burning, produces a bright flame, and is suited for use as an illuminant.
