MOVING TO THE FRONT.

The government at Madrid on Thursday summarily shut off all communication with this government by refusing to wait for President McKinley's ultimatum.

The only alternative left for this government was to order the North Atlantic squadron, which has been lying at Key West, to Havana, and it may be said that war has actually begun.

As a matter of course some anxiety prevails as to the possible outcome of a naval battle. The Spanish are resourceful in tricks and it will require the utmost vigilance on the part of our officers to offset the cunning tactics of the enemy.

As soon as the intentions of the enemy are known our navy will know better what to do. There is no doubt a plan has been outlined for the invasion of the island and our forces will co-operate with those of General Gomez.

Spain will bear a terrible disadvantage on this side of the ocean as her coal supply once exhausted she would be powerless to inflict serious injury and may fall an easy prey.

It will not be surprising should the few hundred Spaniards who left Tampa, Fla., the other day, for Havana, wish themselves back in Tampa before they are ten days older.

RESIGNATION OF POSTMASTER GENERAL GARY.

Many persons in Maryland were given an unwelcome surprise on Thursday by the announcement that Postmaster General James A. Gary had resigned his office.

The Washington correspondent of the Baltimore News says that the President's counselors differ as to the advisability of the immediate invasion of Cuba by a land force.

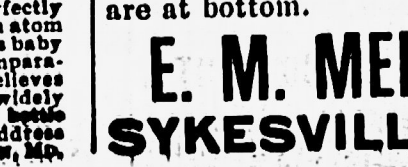
