INDICTMENT

The village of Harrieville, on the Carroll and Frederick county line, about two or three miles from Mount Airy, was practically wiped out by fire at 3 o'clock Sunday afternoon. The fire originated in the large flour mill of Ernest Clark, on the Carroll county side.
