> of the Law regulating the Weighing, Inspecting and Measuring of Grain sold in the City of Bal-By ordering Grain inspected, the Farmers will have the advantage of the inspection gratis; have their Grain weighed and measured by swom officers, who will be entirely independent and impartial, and pay no more for the whole than they usually do for weighing and measuring Gran when those duties are performed by parties (who are not sworn) provided by the purchaser.

In addition, if Grain is refused to be taken by

the buyer, under the law, and for any cause it is rejected, ample provision is made to test the validity of his conduct. If the value of the rejected Grain be less than \$100, the case is to be tried in five days, before a Justice of the Peace, and if it exceed that a mount, it shall be tried at the first term of the Court of Common Pleas, or the Superior Court of Baltimore City, and in either event the seller,
