### THE CITY.

**The War News.**—This force which, as we have already stated, is under the command of Capt. J. P. Levy, is still on active duty. Capt. Shaw, of the steamer *Ameria*, yesterday made the following report: "On Saturday, at five o'clock, in the morning, one of our boats drove down on me about seven miles. When within half a mile of me, fired at me a blank cartridge. Not knowing her to be a man-of-war, and being one of the New York propellers, I was fearful that she was a piratical crew and a crew of pirates. The captain then opened fire, firing about four shots at me—one of them came over the smoke stack and grazed the pilot house. He continued the chase about three-quarters of an hour, when I ran my boat into a small creek, where I lay in wait, prepared to fire. I saw him passing shot and shod, and during the chase, his shot would throw the water on my deck. At seven o'clock I arrived at my wharf."

**The Georgia Guards.**—This newly formed company have their headquarters in the southern part of Franklin and Frederick streets, and are engaged daily in drilling and in making themselves familiar with all that pertains to the life of a soldier.
