MARYLAND LEGISLATURE.

ANSAPOLA, January 11, 1862. SENATE. The Senate was not in session to-day, having adjourned over until Monday.

HOUSE OF DELEGATES. Mr. Dunlop presented a petition of the Judges of the Orphans' Court of Montgomery county asking that a law be passed in relation to free negroes coming into the county, which was referred to the Committee on Colored Population.

Mr. Matthews offered an order directing the Adjutant General to report to the House a list of all military companies to whom arms have been distributed, designating the companies of which the officers are reported to be disloyal.

Mr. Matthews moved to refer the order to the militia committee. The order was then referred.

The bill authorizing the Treasurer to pay the Maryland State Colonization Society an appropriation was read a second time.

The bill authorizing the Court of Appeals to hear petitions for writs of mandamus growing out of the opening of Holliday street was read a third time.

Mr. Matthews was opposed to the passage of this bill for various reasons, among others that it was not right to be placing recent cases before others which have been pending for months before.
