

**AN ACT** to incorporate the Washington Temperance Society of Baltimore.

Sect. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That William K. Mitchell, John F. Ross, Archibald Campbell, David Martin, David Anderson, Daniel A. Riley, James Macaulay, Robert Wilson John Ward, George J. Atkinson, George T. Stetson, Elisha Stearns, Thomas Murphy, John Wright, Francis Gallagher and others, who now are or may hereafter be members of said Society and their successors, are hereby declared to be one corporation and body corporate by the name, style and title of the Washington Temperance Society of Baltimore, and by that name they shall be and are hereby made able and capable to have, receive and retain to them and their successors, property, real and personal, and to do and be agents of any person or persons, bodies corporate or politic, capable of making the same; and to dispose of or transfer all their property. In such manner as they may think proper; Provided, nevertheless, that the said corporation shall not, at any time, buy or sell property, real, personal or mixed, exceed \$100 in value, or issue or hold any note, bill of exchange, draft or other instrument, other than that which may be necessary to a full and complete execution for the purposes of the Society.

Sect. 2. And be it enacted, That the said corporation, and their successors, by the name and title aforesaid, shall be entitled, at least, to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, defend and be defended, in all or any Courts of Law, and before all and any Judges, Officers or Clerks whatsoever, in all and singular actions, matters or demands whatsoever.

Sect. 3. And be it enacted, That the said corporation shall have power to hold stated meetings to establish and put into execution, after or at such time as they see fit, rules and regulations as for their own most convenience to the interests of the Society; provided the same shall not be contrary to the laws of this State or of the United States.

Sect. 4. And be it enacted, That nothing in this act shall be construed as to authorise the said corporation to issue any note, bill of exchange, draft or other evidence of debt to be held to a certain date.

Sect. 5. And be it enacted, That the right is hereby expressly reserved to the Legislature at its pleasure to amend or repeal any act of incorporation.

Sect. 6. And be it enacted, That this act shall endure for thirty years unless sooner repealed by the General Assembly.
