Gosport, near Norfolk, Virginia.

Rations to consist of three-fourths of round or long bread, crepes, or a fourth pound of flour, or two-eighths of hard bread, or one and a fourth pound of corn meal; and at the rate of one hundred rations of eight-pounds of beans, or twice as much of dried beans, or twice as much thereof, twice per week, one hundred and fifty ounces of desiccated potato, and one hundred ounces of mixed vegetables, ten pounds of coffee, one pound of tea, one pound of sugar, fifteen pounds of sugar, four quarts of vinegar, one pound of spermaceti candles, or one and one-fourth pound of tallow; four pounds of soap, and two quarts of oil.

The rations to be delivered upon the order of the Commanding Officer of each station; the first, best, either in bulk or by the single ration, of good round or long bread, or the best flour for hard and hind quarters, necks and kidneys, twice excluded; the pork, No. 1 prime meat pork, the flour, extra superfine; the coffee, good Rio, the sugar, good New Orleans or its equivalent, and the tea, vinegar, candles, soap, salt, &c., to be of good quality.
