FIVE Veterans Regained Maryland Votes—In no time will be granted to the five veterans who were compelled to leave that state last evening but the pleasure of grasping the hands of Lieutenants Ayer and Lieutenant J. C. Morrison, two of the principal leaders of the Marylanders, who have been honorably discharged by the service by their own request—fall in line to be paid, and have had many narrow escapes. They are both residents of this city, and have many war friends here, who are again anxious to meet them. We learn from them that the Regiment is now attached to Gen. Lee's Division, and is in full force, ready for duty for the last two months. Many of the members have fallen by the unerring bullet of a concealed assassin, and have given up the struggle to be equal to any regiments now in service. A great number of the others and men have been honorably discharged, among whom are Capt. E. Norwood, Captain H. M. McMechan, Lt. D. Gage, Captain S. P. Moore, and Lt. W. C. Smith, all of the 1st Division. We also find Captain John K. Hickey, who was severely wounded on the 26th of October in front of Washington, and passed away on Saturday. His body was interred at the Hospital at Annapolis to rest in his home at Pittsburg, Pa. This is the third death of a general in a short time. Captain Charles H. Hays, gallant in battle, was killed at Bull Run, and Captain James Jones, who was severely wounded at Bull Run, died on Saturday. He was a member of the 1st Division, and was a brave soldier. He was buried at the cemetery of the City, where his friends gathered around his bier, and the services were conducted by a chaplain of the 1st Division. He was buried with full military honors.
