A message was received from the President and Secretary of War, containing the annual report of the Secretary of War.

Mr. Schenck, from the Military Committee, reported both the Senate amendment to the bill authorizing the creation of additional regiments. It was passed, and added to the Secretary Extraord. bill, and the title read as follows: "An act in regard to the organization of additional regiments and the Extraord. bill."

Mr. Schenck made a report from the Committee on Commerce on the bill establishing a Bureau of Fisheries and Affairs. It is introduced in the War Department, and applies to Indians (regardless of color) and African slaves.

The report was agreed to.
