HEADQUARTERS U. S. ARMY, THE OHIO, BALTIMORE, April 27.

General Orders No. 31.—The Commanding General has the satisfaction of announcing to the people of North Carolina, that hostilities within this State have definitely ceased. That for the war to be ended, and that the people will soon be restored throughout the country.

It is now the duty of all to cultivate friendly relations with the people of the North, and to be prepared to meet the needs of the people of the South.

All good and peaceable citizens will be protected and treated with kindness. While the laws of the Federal Government will be enforced, the laws of the State will be enforced.

The troops will be distributed so as to secure the interests of the United States Government and protect the people until a civil government can be established in harmony with the Constitution and laws of the United States.

The most perfect discipline and good conduct are enjoined upon all officers, soldiers, and civilians.

All who are peacefully disposed are invited to return to their homes, and to resume their normal life.

Some of the troops will be supplied with subsistence stores from the Commissary Department.

It is the duty of the Government to punish those political leaders who are responsible for the destruction of the property of the people of the United States.

Between the Government and the people of North Carolina there is peace.
