The strict blockade of the place, however, continued, and Kars surrendered in Noember, the troops being nearly exhausted by fa nine. All the attempts made by the l'arkish Government to relieve the place had failed. General Kmety had for some time recided in England. He had been indisposed for a few months past, but his death was unexpected. An attack of paralysis terminated his existence yesterday at 5 o'clock. He was only 54 years

The day from which the old Brussels and the point l'Alencon were made was cultivated on purpose: it was chiefly grown in Brabant.
