LETTER FROM WASHINGTON.

(Correspondence of the Baltimore Clipper.) Washington, May 27, 1865.

The Honorable Two Days—President John.

We Americans are often charged by foreign critics with a want of exaggeration, which is easily exemplified in our notices of public displays and of public men—the former being generally made up of plaudits and exactions, and the latter illustrating Day's sarcasm.

“Every man with us is God or Devil.”

This compliment, I confess, will doubtless be thrown upon us by some of the papers of the North. At Washington, May 26 and 28, 1861. Yet those to whom the spectacles of Tuesday and Wednesday last can be known only by description will have, at best, but a poor conception of their splendor and grandeur and variety. Hull less will quiet home readers of these account be able to realize the deep and innumerable feelings, and the high and not unexciting speculations which the actual scenes inspired in all who are accustomed to think or feel about anything, or to attend to the circumstances by which they are surrounded.

Hundreds of pets have been employed in giving to the journals of America a scope something like that which we find in our military periodicals; if it may have been due to any man who had the means of being heard through the press, to refrain from giving utterance to his thoughts and emotions. For the next generation the journals of this week will have a singular interest. The ingenuous student will revert to them for the purpose of tracing the impresses made upon the minds of the spectators and their contemporaries, by the march through the national capitals of those mighty armies who saved the American Republic from dismemberment; and for the purpose, also, of observing the effects of the various forms of peace which those armies had adopted.

He far from being liable to the charge of exaggeration, I am of opinion that most men and women of sensibility and reflection regard the descriptions and reports as falling below rather than rising above the reality.

Copies of the leading journals containing them ought, therefore, to be preserved in every family, as the contemporaneous and best records of events, which will appear still greater and more momentous to those who shall walk these streets and look upon the great public edifices of Washington in after years. The powers that passed before our eyes had the strongest irritant effect upon the nerves of the spectators of peace while those armies had adopted.
