ANOTHER MAILROAD DISAPPEARS.
COLLISION BETWEN NEW HAVEN AND HARLEM TRAINS.

At 9 o'clock this morning the Harlem Railroad train which left Pavillion at 6 A. M., was struck by the New Haven train going north, and several passengers were injured.

The collision took place on the high trestle bridge between Harlem and the Yonkers tunnel, both going at a high rate of speed; and although there is a double track at that point the last car of the Harlem train had badly stalled becoming in contact with the New Haven.

It is reported that the bridge settled in consequence of the tremendous weight of both trains bearing upon one point; and as the up-track and down-track are very close together, the cars were either repelled, but immediately came together again, when all the windows of the Harlem car were smashed and many persons were injured by glass and broken wood.

Mr. Dewitt, a lawyer of this city, who lives at Mount Vernon, was severely hurt in the arm. Another gentleman was badly cut in the fleshy part of the arm. Scarcely a person in the Harlem cars could be found uninjured.

The passengers complain that the engineers do not obey the regulations, which require a low rate of speed in crossing this bridge. This morning both the Harlem and New Haven trains were going north, and the New Haven train had a narrow escape from death. The bridge is seventy feet high, and if this reckless driving is continued a fearful catastrophe may be looked for. The persons in fault should be punished—N. P. FORD, Saturday.

SMOKING AT ETON COLLEGE.
The plague, of which the Eton scholars had been much afraid in Elizabeth's day, returned again with far greater virulence, and after a long time of driving it does not seem that on either side has it been very fatal in the school itself, at least but few deaths are recorded in the Eton registers. But it gave rise to a remarkable ordinance as to the use of tobacco, which apparently originated with modern rules. Let old Thomas Iteane give it his own words:

"Even children were obliged to smoke, and I remember that I heard formerly Tom Rogers, who was Yeoman Beadle, tell the scholars that year school boys were obliged to smoke the pipe every morning; and that he was never whipped so much in his life as he was one morning for not smoking."

Later events connect the whipping with smoking in a different way. It was "Blackened" Rogers.

DIREFUL FIRES IN RUSSIA.—On the third of June, more than two hundred houses were burnt down in Vitebsk, and no sooner had the fire been extinguished than more than four hundred houses were burnt down at Borsod. At Tambov three fires had occurred, which were soon extinguished, but the government of that town is the most to blame.
