CHAMP PERGEDON, THE OVERHILLA The case of Champ Ferguson, the famous rebel guerilla, is still on trial before the Military Commission, at Memphis. Seme of the borrors of guerilla warfare may be gathered from the following: On Saturday, Miss Ether A. Jackson, a witness for the prosecution, was sworm and deposed as follows:—I am a daughter of James Zachary, of Fentress county: I was at home at the time my father was killed; it was on the 1st of June, 1962; a company of mineteen men came up; it was about ten o'clock in the day; Champ Ferguson, and a number of others whom I recognized, was in the gang; my father was between the house and the stable, about fifty yards from the house; the first man who shot was Fayate Allen, and cried out "balt" after shooting, and all the others shot after him, crying "shoot him, -- him, shoot him!" They ran out of the orchard into a woods, and then I heard some one of them cry "don't shoot a dead

They returned to the house. Ferguson came to the door, and the dog was on the porch, and he raised his gun to shoot it .-A told him not to shoot him, that I would take him away. Ferguson then went into the bouse and asked for father's navy revolver, and said "we have killed your father." I asked him if father did not have his revolver with him when he killed him. Ferguson said no. I told him that he had it with him when he left the house, and that I did not know where it was. He searched the house and then returned to the woods and found it. He came back, and set on the rorch, and loaded his revolver. I spoke to him about Stokely Evans, whom he had a prisoner. He said he would not harm him. He did not give any reason for killing my father. body to the house.
