INTERESTING ABOUT THE CATTLE DISEASE

Whatever may be the origin of the disease, the problem of stopping its progress has not yet been solved, in spite of all that scientific wisdom has suggested.

Veterinary skill seems to be nearly powerless, and the talk is rather of staying the disease by destruction than cure.

Medical questions which have caused much inquiry whether any persons who have attended upon the diseased animals have been in any way affected, say that no single instance of the kind has come to their knowledge.

But in relation to the effect which the milk and flesh of diseased animals may have upon the health of those who consume, either through ignorance or otherwise, there are some facts which are most alarming.

Written for you, the milk of a cow slightly diseased afforded evidence of the disease in two days. The post-mortem appearances of one that died were those of typhus—general inflammation of the intestines, stomach, brain, etc.; the blood a bilious purp; red globules decomposed as though it had been subjected to strong fumes of hydrogen.

It is stated in an article in one of the London papers, signed by a physician, that a suspicious infection is daily manifesting itself amongst infants, particularly those between the ages of two and eight months.

The symptoms are an erratic typhus, with a sporadic phrenitis, pneumonia, constipation or diarrhea, and petechia; indeed, all the exact characteristics arise from the specific poison devastating the system.

It is worth noting that the "cattle disease" has reached one of the most solid and quiet breeding grounds of Rhode Island, etc., etc.
