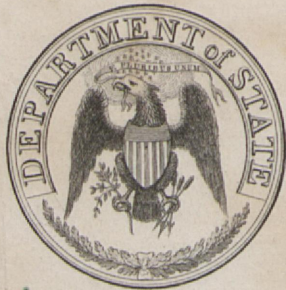

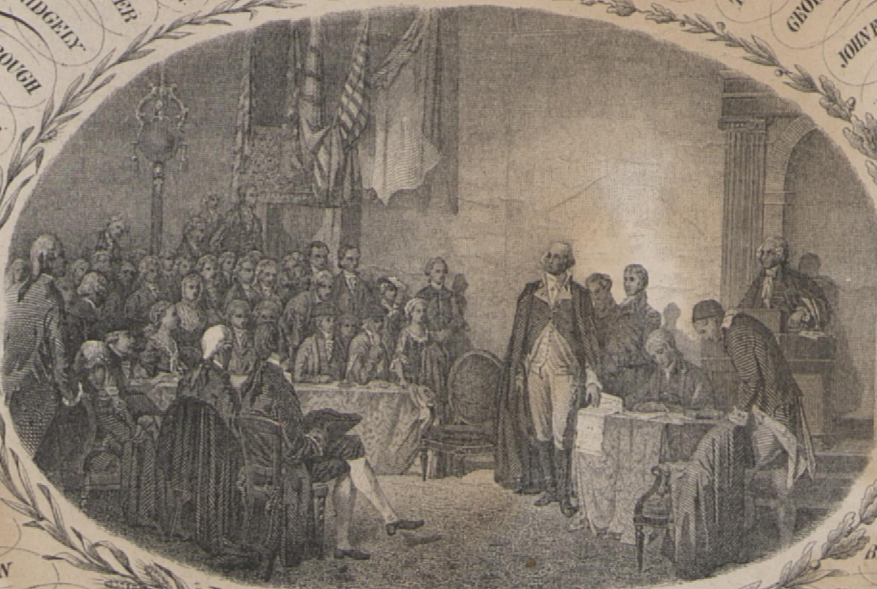

## Be it Known,



That reposing special trust and confidence in your Fidelity, Courage, Good Conduct, and attachment to the State of Maryland and the United States, you are by these Presents constituted and appointed Captain of the 1st Regiment 1st Brigade 1st Division M.H. in conformity to the provisions of the Act of the General Assembly passed January session 1867 Chapter 357



You are therefore carefully to discipline the Officers and Soldiers under your command who are hereby strictly enjoined to obey you as their Captain

and in this, and in all other respects you are diligently to discharge the trust committed to you by these Presents according to the Constitution and Laws of this State and of the United States and such Rules and Regulations as are or may be established under the authority thereof.

This Commission to be in full force until lawfully revoked.

Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the State of Maryland at Annapolis this Twelfth day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty seven

der him every possible assistance in the discharge of his duties.  
Done at Head quarters White Sulphur Springs This VI day  
of August 1859, in witness whereof the Said Board of War  
has caused to be hereunto affixed its great Seal, and the Official  
Signature of the Commander in Chief, as also the Signature  
of the Secretary of Said Board.
