



A denotes the Mouth of Chicoms Creek, the beginning of the Indian Land. Then up said Creek bounded therewith to letter B. to Head of said Creek, then with the rest of Francis Underdon's Branch, then down said Branch bounded therewith to the River, at D, then down said River, bounded therewith to the first Beginning, containing 5834 acres of land clear of any Patterson Land.
