The John T. Warfield House is significant as a well-preserved, early nineteenth century house that has passed down to the descendants of the original owner, the Dorseys, for over 200 years. This family and their Warfield descendants were prominent inhabitants of the Laytonside and Goshens areas. Joshua W. Dorsey, the builder of the house, was a trustee of the Goshens School and a major landowner in the area.

<p>The house is a two story, brick building with a four bay facade. At either end are external end chimneys with two story bases and free standing stacks. The transom lit doorway is in the second bay from the west end. The windows are ^{9/6} double hung sash on the ground floor and 6/6 on the second floor. It is laid up in Flemish bond. A one story porch runs across the main facade. Attached to it is a 1-1/2 story kitchen wing with a flush gable chimney on the north gable end. The cornices of this and each of the other sections is three courses of projecting headers.</p> <p>In plan, the house has two rooms divided by the staircase, which is enclosed by a vertical beaded board partition wall. The stairs rise from the north to south, with a landing which is approached from both rooms. The interior walls are brick. The fireplace in the west room has a beaded board surround; the mantle is supported by free standing columns; the frieze is a concave reeded band. The fireplace in the east room is simpler, with fluted pilasters. The east room also has a chair-rail of beaded fascia, capped with roll moulding. The doors have low panels.</p>
